Part 3 How to Dedicate Your Life Free of Generational Curses

Today I will discuss with you how to break generational curses. Before I start, I would like to make few things clear so I may not be either misunderstood or misquoted.

I do believe that a born-again believer lacks nothing and is secure in the Lord as far as the believer's spiritual life is concern. What I mean is, that the believer's eternal life and standing is secure as long they don't turn away from the Lord and deny Him. However, what I will discuss with you today is about how to make the life of a believer, while on earth, free from generational curses which hinder the believer's walk with Jesus. There is a difference. Jesus's sacrifice is sufficient for our eternal and future standing, but our earthly temporal life is often hindered either because of our lack of obedience or because of lack of practical Christian knowledge, not being passed from church leaders to the believers. To get free from generational curses requires a special request in the form of petition.

Let's look at few scriptures:

'The LORD is slow to anger and abundant in faithful love, forgiving iniquity and transgression, but he won't acquit the guilty. <u>He recalls the iniquity of fathers to the third and fourth generation</u>.' (Num 14:18)

"No Ammonite or Moabite may participate in the assembly of the LORD, and none of their descendants shall be admitted to the assembly of the LORD, to the tenth generation," (Deut. 23:3)

- ❖ Generational curses are passed over from family lines that have transgressed the law of God through blood covenants.
- ❖ It is a great error to assume that generational curses are automatically removed once a person become born-again. Although God is sovereign, and can do all at will, practical experience suggests that to be the exception rather than the rule.
- ❖ When one is converted to Christ, all sins of the person are forgiven, and the person's eternal future is secure as far as the person's spiritual life is concerned. However, the sins and the blood-covenants of the forefathers still have binding on the person's natural life in the form of generational curses.
- ❖ Generational curses remain in force when blood covenants are made by the forefathers such as freemasons, Satanists, secret society groups, occultists, incest, rape, and bloodshed.

In order to be freed from generational curses, Christians should ask God in prayer and fast in order to break those curses in the following manner:

- 1) Forgiving the forefathers and their family lines for the blood covenants that have bearing on them;
- 2) Renounce the sins of their forefathers and their family lines (known and unknown);
- 3) Ask God to separate their natural and spiritual lives from the sins of their forefathers and their family lines, and to attach them to the family line of God through Jesus Christ in the natural as per the promise given to Abraham (Genesis 12:2).
- 4) Ask God to perform supernatural healing in their lives from the effects of the sins of their forefathers.
- 5) To dedicate their children and posterity to Jesus Christ free of the forefather's blood-covenants.

<u>Model of Prayer:</u>

Abba Father, in the name of Jesus Christ I (we) renounce the sins of my (our) forefathers through my parents' (and generational lines, that have bearing on my (our) life(s) and my family and children. I (we) choose to forgive my (our) forefathers for their sins and their effects on my (our) life(s), and I (we) ask you to separate me (us) and my family and children from their blood covenants and generational curses for ever. Lord, I (we) ask that from now on, you will attach my (our) family line to the family line of Jesus Christ through whom I (we) am (are) saved by a covenant in His precious blood. I (we) also dedicate my (our) family, children and posterity to you Lord, for your glory. May you Lord, I (we) pray, heal me (us) and our family and children from the effects of those generational curses in my (our) life(s). Lord, I (we) ask this in prayer, not because of merit but because of Your great mercy shown to us through Jesus our Lord. I (we) praise Your great Name with a thankful heart(s). May all the glory come to You. Amen.

The prayer should be followed by a command to address the spirit world.

Model of Command:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I (we) break all generational curses upon my (our) life(s) and command you Satan and all your demons attached to those generational curses to leave my (our) life(s) and the life(s) of my family and children forever and to go where Jesus Christ commands you to go and never to return.

After this I recommend that you (and your spouse and children if you have) get anointed with oil as per <u>James 5:13, 14</u>.

<u>Caution:</u> Please don't attempt to do this if you live in active sin against the Lord or if you are still bitter with unforgiveness. (Matthew 6:14, 15)
